The property assessment in Crystal Springs for the 2021 taxation year increased by 6.59% compared to 2020 Municipal Property Tax for 2020 remained at \$292,433 compared to 2020 (\$292,433).

The Provincial School Requisition increased by approximately 1.5% (\$2,838)

The Overall Property Taxes increased by \$2,240 in 2021 compared to 2021

The minimum tax remains at \$800.

The annual wastewater levy remained at \$240 annually in 2020.

The annual wastewater levy covers expenses for Regional and Local wastewater operations & funds future reserves. 2021 Operating budget has a projected surplus of \$13,274 for Capital projects and reserves.

2021 Capital and Operating Projects:

Road projects (Estimated at \$500 K), Signage and Speed Signs (\$23 K), Boat Launch (\$10 K), Wastewater (\$13 K) Provincially Fund Lake Management Project carry forward to 2021 (\$132 K)
